Job Title: Family Ministry Coordinator: Reports to the Senior Pastor

Position Overview: This person will have a desire to connect with spiritually deprived families in our community through compassionate efforts to identify them with Jesus Christ.

Essential Responsibilities:

- Will identify those families in our area who meet the criteria of the position overview and begin the process of establishing relationships.
- Will develop a plan that will develop the family (including single parent families) biblically to build a cohesive and healthy family unit.
- Will recruit, train, lead and encourage a Family leadership team which will share in the leadership of our Family ministry.
- Will engage in personal discipleship with each parent (father and/or mother) with a mature member of the leadership team and having each parent lead their family in devotions on a regular basis with an accountability partner.
- Will encourage the families to participate in mission and evangelism opportunities in their neighborhoods and community.
- Will be available to the families through regular contact, mentoring, and counseling.
- Will encourage parents to use social media to engage, equip, and encourage them with tools to become wiser and better parents.
- Will continue his/her development by attending training conferences, seminars, and other education opportunities.
- Will continue to evaluate the various components of the Family ministry.
- Will also focus on the Biblical development of Middle School and High School students within the family unit.
- Will help to fundraise to support the ministry

Job Skills Required:

- Must be committed to Christian faith, belief in God the Father, God the Son and God the Holy Spirit
- Must agree with the EFCA statement of faith or have a conservative and complimentary perspective (theology) of scripture
- Must have a working knowledge/experience of the struggles and conflicts of living in the urban core
- Must know how to communicate well in a public setting
- Must have leadership and organizational skills
- Must have a working knowledge of curriculum and classroom management
- Must be able to communicate well with teenagers
- Must have a working knowledge of the community

Educational Requirement:

- Bachelor's degree in urban ministry or minimum of 5 years' experience in urban ministry
